Summary of Pupil Premium Funding 2018 / 19

Item / Project	Resources Required	Cost	Objective and Impact
1-1 Tutoring	Teacher	£600	One child received additional 1 to 1 tutoring for maths in Year 6. She moved from Below National expectations (99) to meeting National expectations in the Year 6 SATs (105)
Small group teaching	Teacher	£8,000	A small group of 4 children; 2 in Year 4 and two in Year 5 received significant additional work three days a week for their English and Maths. The children are significantly under-attaining in these areas and small group work is ensuring that their progress improves. There has been great progress, particularly in year 5 with both children making good progress (from 70 to 82 and 87 in reading and from 73 to 83 and from 90 to 92 respectively in maths.
Residential Visits	Financial support for families who are unable to afford the costs,	£890	4 pupils in receipt of pupil premium had their residential visit costs subsidised. (Two in Year 6 , two in Year 5) They would not have gone on this visit without the subsidy and would have missed out on a valuable learning experience.
Additional Support in Maths and English through Kumon	Kumon	£1,000	1 pupil received additional support for his English and Maths through Kumon. He attained well in his KS2 assessments (R -108, M-109, SPAG-110).
Additional TAs support to fund interventions.	25 hours additional support	£11,000	Pupil Premium Grant funds the use of TAs across the school. They are able to deliver specific interventions with Pupil premium children prioritised.

Small group teaching	Teacher and one to one TA	£8,000	The small group of children now in Year 5 and 6 mentioned above to continue to receive support through a qualified and experienced teacher and dedicated one to one intervention teaching. Progress levels to continue to improve.
Residential Visits	Financial support for families who are unable to afford the costs	£900	4 pupils may need support with their residential visits costs
Additional TAs support to fund interventions.	25 hours additional support	£11,000	Pupil Premium Grant funds the use of TAs across the school. These Teaching Assistants deliver Interventions to ensure progress is good for Pupil Premium children.
