1-1 Tutoring	Teacher	£600	One child received additional 1 to 1 tutoring for maths in Year 6. He was assessed (using internal assessments at reaching the expected standard in Maths at the end of year 6
Visits	Financial support for families who are unable to afford the costs,	£320	All Pupil Premium children had visits subsidised by the school. These were mainly to Hill End this year. They would not have gone on these visits without the subsidy and would have missed out on a valuable learning experience.
1 :1 support	One to one TA for a child with behaviour difficulties	10,000	1 pupil received one to one TA support to help him access the curriculum, maintain relationships and have a positive school experience.
