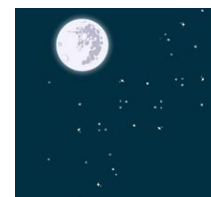




Year 1 Term 1 2023-24



Reach for the stars!

English Lots of our literacy work will be focussed on the book "Look Up!" by Nathan Byron and Dapo Adeola. We will use this and other books to practise our fine motor skills in our handwriting, recap our segmenting and blending skills in phonics, develop our rhyming skills with some poetry and build on our writing skills with sentence work.

Geography We will think about what can be seen from space and draw our own simple map. We will start to name the seven continents.

PE indoors we will be making our own starry skies dance.

Outdoors we will be throwing and catching.

Maths We will be developing fluency in counting forwards and backwards to 20, and using language such as more, less, greater than, less than and equals. We will learn pairs of numbers that add together to make single digit numbers; count in tens, and recognise 2D and 3D shapes in different orientations.

Science We will be naming parts of the human body. We will use our senses to investigate our environment and start to look for signs of Autumn.

History We will be recognising the difference between the past and present. We will learn about the moon landings and hear from someone who can remember them. We will sequence historical events in order.

Art We will be learning about the life and art of Kandinsky, and using his pictures to inspire our own work. We will be naming primary colours and starting to mix them to make our own colours for printing and painting.

PSHCE Our learning this term will be around the physical health and wellbeing. We will think about celebratory food and games in different cultures and staying safe outdoors.

SMSC: Our themes are quality, perseverance, respect and hope under our termly value of **Passion for Learning**.

Enrichment: We will go on an autumn walk to explore our local countryside and find out about seasonal changes.

RE We will think about what groups we belong to and learn about how some different faith groups show belonging. We will visit the church to learn about baptism in Christianity.
